Does Chinese Feng Shui Work in the Southern Hemisphere?

INTRODUCTION

Does Feng Shui work both in the Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere? How does it apply to Australia? How does it apply to the Equatorial regions?

It is a critical query and a most important aspect when we are applying Feng Shui in Australia. It is also a common argument in Australian Feng Shui interest groups and educational campus.

Almost 85% of my Australian students and clients have asked about it, as they can't find any literature written with theoretical explanations regarding this query in the general English version Feng Shui books or magazines.

It does not mean there is no research regarding this Feng Shui study in the Feng Shui professional research field. In fact, since 1996 a group of Chinese cultural background Feng Shui Masters, including myself, in Hong Kong and Taiwan has formed a Forum to do research and run many live experiments on this subject. I'm the only one of the Feng Shui Masters based in Australia to conduct this type of research work, and run live case studies during Feng Shui consultations for my Australian clients.

As we know, Hong Kong, Taiwan and China have been recognized as the **Feng Shui Kingdom** of the World, where conducting research works and keenly applying traditional Chinese Feng Shui is part of daily life.

Does Chinese Feng Shui Work in the Southern Hemisphere?

I'll try to compile and consolidate our main opinions, in response to your query regarding this subject. Of course, our professional forum is still doing research and monitoring live case experiments worldwide.

I can't explain it in depth, as the Chinese-English cultural translations and the limitations of English phrase expressions are restrictive. Of course, my fresh English learner writing skill also limits it.

This paper will generally highlight **Form Feng Shui**, and **Formulae Feng Shui** to describe how they bring out the Application Differences between the Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere regions.

After you've read it, you'll have an elementary understanding of the **Core Concept** of this issue, and you'll also get basic background information for your further study with our Chinese culture Feng Shui Research Masters.

As well, you may find that there are some differences from what you've read and been told in the current English Feng Shui books and seminars on the market. We can't advise with any comments on this business issue; you need to justify from your own knowledge.

THE FORM

Feng Shui Application consists of two parts, they are:

- **Form Feng Shui**
- **Formulae Feng Shui**

In Form Feng Shui investigation it is generally assumed that the **Environment** can be physically seen, we can use our body to touch. The **OBJECTS** we are dealing with should occupy 3-dimensional space.

For the site, we use the theory of **Heaven-Cross** and the **Four Gods** mapping. The term of Four Gods, you may commonly know, are expressed in the symbolic heaven animals: Green Dragon, White Tiger, Red Phoenix and Black Tortoise.

The term **Heaven-Cross** means the positioning of the **Four Gods**.

The term **Sham** is used to describe and examine all exterior static objects on the ground. The fortune or misfortune of which is according to their shape or geometric form. Generally, this is expressed in the symbolic aspects of the **Form of Nine Stars** and their nature of Five Elements.

Form of Nine Stars are the symbolic expression of the Big Dipper Star Systems in ancient China, they are:

Tam-Long (nature of Five Element is Wood), Gey-Mun (Earth), Lu-Tsyn (Earth), Man-Kuk (Water), Lim-Zing (Fire), Mou-Kuk (Metal), Po-Gwen (Metal), Zo-Fu (Metal) and Jou-Bet Water).

The term **Sham**, some interpreters translate as generally meaning **Mountains** in the English language, but it is not actually true. It symbolizes

all static objects on the landscape both in Yin and Yang form, and includes hills, buildings, ground level, man-made objects...etc.

The expression of **Form of Nine Stars** in the Form Feng Shui does not have the same meaning as the **Flying Stars of Nine Stars** in Formulae Feng Shui, we also take care of this.

We investigate the **Static Objects** surrounding the site, and the interior placements are traditionally based on their physical arrangements, for instance, the placement of position, balancing of each other, ratio of the size, angle of the line, extension, hollow, geometric form...etc.

Their existing form and physical status should be the same anywhere on the Earth.

The **Movement** in Form Feng Shui is traditionally expressed as **Water**, including rivers, the sea, waterways, ponds, traffic, roads, bridges, man-made moveable objects...etc.

We interpret **Water** with the expression **Lovely** or **Loveless**. It depends on its physical flowing form on ground level. For instance, whether the water is running down or up, winding or straight, fast or gentle, dead or live, cross or meet, natural or man-made, underground or on the surface, ...etc.

All physical surrounding objects not only affect human beings, but also affect all the non-human life at a target site. You may raise a query that does **Form Feng Shui** service all living things on Earth?

Of course it does. Beside this, in Form Feng Shui, for human beings, we're also looking at the relationship and symbolic expression of the **Interior Form** in the micro living and working area.

The healthy state of **Organs**, **Mind effect** and **Personal/Family** matters of the residents is mostly linked to the expressions of this Interior Form. These aspects solely affect human beings.

This is another study area of Form Feng Shui. For ease of understanding, I interpret it in a new English phrase, **Mindscape Feng Shui**.

However, this new English term still does not yet fully express its actual meaning.

Anyway, when we're viewing and feeling the surrounding objects, which may lie in the Northern Hemisphere or in the Southern Hemisphere regions, they should be identical to each other.

The term Frontage, the Back, the Left, the Right and the Center, all have the same definition whatever location you're standing in and which direction you're facing.

The mind effect and healthy state of organs of the residents, all have the same expressing rules whether the house is sited in Hong Kong or in Australia.

Therefore, in conclusion, from the point of view of **Form Feng Shui** - the processing of geographic aspects on the Object Form - a site location, a house, even an interior bedroom, for instance, should have the **Same** view; whether they are positioned in the Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere, or Equator. There is **NO DIFFERENCE** at all.

THE FORMULAE

Formulae Feng Shui is a set of mathematical calculations, which are bonded in pre-designed **Frames**.

They need some input **parameters**. For instance, the symbolic number combinations of the **Ho-Tou** and **Lu-Shu** diagrams, **Five Elements** and **Kua**, **Heavenly Stems** and **Earthly Branches**, **Current Time** and **Era of Cycle**.

The results are aspects of **Chi**. We analyse Chi in the symbolic form of **Five Elements**. By examining them, we can find out the different kinds of **Luck** or **Sha** on a **target resident** who is living in a **target house**.

Modern instruments in our physical world can't measure the subtle vibrant of the Five Elements. They're relying on the human mind, the perceptive intuition, and the application skills of Formulae Feng Shui.

Therefore, the **CORE** of the calculations of the Formulae is the **Five Elements**, we need to understand their real principal prior to dealing with **Formulae Feng Shui**.

The Five Elements consist of **Metal, Wood, Water, Fire** and **Earth**. They exist in the form of subtle Chi, vibrant in our living environment, or even you may say, in the universe.

You're a being that is also **encoded** by the Five Elements in terms of your date of birth, time of birth, geographic regional zone of your birth and even from the last generations of your race.

Our date and time of birth are expressed in the symbolic **Heavenly Stems** and **Earthly Branches**, as well as the relationship of the **Twenty-Four Seasonal Notes** of the traditional Chinese calendar.

There are **Ten Heavenly Stems** : Chia, Yi, Ping, Ding, Mo, Kei, Geng, Xin, Ren and Kui.

There are **Twelve Earthly Branches** : Tze, Chou, Yan, Mao, Chen, Ssu, Wu, Mei, Shum, Yu, Shu and Hai.

All **Heavenly Stems** and **Earthly Branches** have been mapped to a **specific Five Elements** based on their **original development region**. They're mixed in a pool of **math** that uses calculations to determine the **Relative Strength**, the **Active** and **Inactive**, the **Dead** and **Alive** against the **Seasonal Notes**.

If you are born in Sydney --- the Southern Hemisphere region, during the 2nd day in the month of March, as the season of Sydney is coming into Autumn, it is **Active** for the **Metal** Element.

But John born in Hong Kong --- the Northern Hemisphere region, during the 2nd day in month of March, as the season of Hong Kong is coming into Spring, it is **Active** for the **Wood** Element.

The birthdays are expressed in the symbolic form of **Four Pillars and Eight Characters**. These parameters will fit a set of Frameworks to perform calculations and mapping. The outcome, i.e. the combination and weighting of **Life Five Elements** should be different to each other (in the above example). It is because we're considering the factors of time and the geographic regions.

The **Yin Yang Five Elements** originated from the math of **Ho-Tou** and **Lu-Shu**. The **Original Kua** (i.e. The Trigrams of Pa-Kua) and the **Form Kua** (i.e. the I-Kua of the Book of Changes) are also developed based on **Ho-Tou** and **Lu-Shu**. Their Framework of Math **CANNOT be ALTERED**, they are the Source of the Universe.

But, the Yin Yang Five Elements can be **mapped** to different parameters according to the different environments and the time of changes. It is the Principle of the application of Formulae Feng Shui.

We know that the **Concept** of **Ying Yang Five Elements** originally developed in the middle of ancient China, near the City of **Lu-Yang**. Later, their application spread throughout entire China.

Therefore, we commonly call them the **Lu-Yang Five Elements**. As it is assumed that the **Ho-Tou Grid** and **Lu-Shu Grid** on the shell of the Heaven Turtle came from the river **Lu**, near the City of **Lu-Yang**.

The City of **Lu-Yang** is located in the middle of the Northern Hemisphere, so the Lu-Yang Five Elements are also called the **Northern Hemisphere Five Elements** - that which we're now using and dealing with in Feng Shui throughout the World! Most English version Feng Shui books and magazines in the market are based on them to examine the Feng Shui in non-Chinese Communities. It is fine for general Feng Shui interest readers but not for professional use.

Another aspect, the Five Elements of the **24 Shams** (or to simplify we call them the 24 directions of the compass) on the **Law-Pon**, or Lo-Pan (the Feng Shui Compass) are also based on the Lu-Yang Five Elements.

Therefore, the original expression of the **24 Shams** in the **Northern Hemisphere** are as follows:

Hai, Tze and Kui form the **Northern Grid**, they are classified as the **Water** Element.

Yan, Chia, Mao, Yi and Chen form the **Eastern Grid**, they are classified as the **Wood** Element.

Ssu, Bing, Wu, Ding and Mei form the **Southern Grid**, they are classified as the **Fire** Element.

Shum, Geng, Yu, Xin and Shu form the **Western Grid**, they are classified as the **Metal** Element.

Mo and Kei are mixed of Fire and Earth to produce the core of hot Earth, they are classified as the **Earth** Element.

The ancient Chinese, who lived in the middle of China, developed these Grids. They felt the cold from the North side (ie. the Northern Pole), the hot from the South side (ie. the Equator).

Conversely, for the Aboriginal living in Australia, they feel the cold from the South side (ie. the Southern Pole), the hot from the North side (ie. the Equator).

The people living in Malaysia, feel the hot all year round, but they enjoy a little bit of cooling wind from the North and South sides.

Now, please do not confuse the differences between :

- the direction of South and North, expressed in the term of the 24 Shams; and
- the Heaven South and Earth North, they're expressed in the symbolism of I-Kua.

Therefore, when we apply the geographic situations by using the 24 Shams in the **Southern Hemisphere regions**, it is logically considered that the **Southern Grid** will be classified as **Water** Element, the **Northern Grid** will be classified as **Fire** Element, **all other Grids should remain the same as their original nature.**

In the **Equatorial regions**, both the **Northern Grid** and **Southern Grid** will be classified as the **Water Element**, **all other Grids should remain the same as their original nature**.

In the past thousands of years of Feng Shui history in ancient China, many Formulae Frameworks have been developed. Mostly, Feng Shui services were provided to the Noble Officers who were living in huge palace style houses.

The Developers, based in their own geographic region, using on-site live cases and the resulting statistical outcomes, modified and fine tuned the frameworks from time to time. Of course, the original theory of Feng Shui wasn't changed.

The altering and improvement works are still ongoing in modern days. We understand that we can't rely on **Individual Formulae** to achieve the best Feng Shui results in a no boundary modern world.

As each Formulae has its own limitation and its originating geographic background, they do not fulfill the modern complex environment, especially as we're now living in busy communities where there are buildings full of man-made materials.

If you truly understand how some Feng Shui Formulae work, you'll find out different Formulae can have different outcomes and assessments for the **Same** property in the same location. It is due to the fact they are using different mapping parameters although they originated from the **Same Source**.

In ancient China, the Feng Shui Masters performed Feng Shui investigations mostly based on one framework that was inclusively related to their geographic area. It is not strange then, that Feng Shui investigating style is a little bit different between central China and southern China zone.

Clients always employed Feng Shui Masters who lived in the same geographic zone, as they had a specified framework to serve them.

Nowadays, professional Feng Shui masters will not only rely on a **Single Framework** to conduct Feng Shui services in our **no** boundary World.

For the same reason, we can't **use only** a single Formulae of **Flying Stars**, or **East West Four Mansions** to service our clients.

Every Formulae has its **own limitation** and doesn't fulfill all conditions in this modern complicated environment, especially as we're living in the World which is full of man-made material structures.

Prior to examining a house we always **integrate** some pre-selected Formulae rather than only using a single Formulae. Even in an individual Formulae investigation, we sometimes need to prepare various **Star Grid Charts** (in Flying Star Formulae, for example) for a target house to **model** different situations against the target property and residents. You may know there are 216 Star Grid Combinations in the Three Eras Nine Cycles.

It is because we place the considerations of **residents** in the highest **priority** rather than the house itself. If we can focus on human beings, then all the **Static Formulae Frameworks** will be placed in the **GUEST** position, and the residents – human beings will be the **HOST**. It is the core of Feng Shui.

If we can realize that, this work will compliment some geographic factors and calculating limitations in the Formulae Feng Shui. Consequently, the most benefit is, it is **NOT** necessary to **Alter** the **Core Works** of any formulae while applying them in the different environment on the Earth.

Of course, you should **ALSO** understand some practical techniques when you apply various Formulae in the Southern Hemisphere regions, for instance :

- how you **Select** the **right** frameworks and **integrate** them, and know the differences between them
- how you use the **modeling and mapping** technique for the Formulae Feng Shui framework
- how you utilize the principal of **Single Door & Multi-Doors** for a house or a shop; especially considering the building structures of modern properties which differ from ancient China Palace style. For instance, modern houses may have front door, garage door, family room sliding door, balcony, big open windows...etc.

- how you analyse the residents' prior **Historical Events**, **convert** them as **input parameters** and **match** them to one of the pre-selected Formulae framework or grid
- how you analyse the **Message of Kua** which is noted in the Outer bound and Inner bound on the **Lo-Pan**

For example, if you prefer to use the **Formulae of Flying Star** as a pre-selected framework, you need to draw up some Star Grid Charts and analyse the **Effect of Stars Combination**, you may also need to understand more in detail about the following practices:

- Ancient Chinese Feng Shui script stated that "xxxxxxxx,xxxxx." English means: **Heaven** is mapped as a **Circle**, **Earth** is mapped as a **Square**; the Diameter of the **Circle** is 1, its Circumference is **3**; the shortest two points of the **Square** is 1, its Circumference is **4**.
- It is expressed in modern mathematics as: the formulae of the circumference of a circle is $2\pi r$, where the r is the radius, the π is the constant of 3.141592...The Numeral of the Lu-Shu Grid, used the simple rounded-off digit "3." As the "3" is the Prime Number in the square root formulae calculation, it can drive out the last single digits of 1, 3, 7, 9, so that it is also means the **Heaven** primary number is the **"3"**
- the Square consists of 4 sides, but the **"2"** is the smallest fraction of 4, take this digit **"2"** in the square root formulae calculation, it can drive out the last single digits of 2, 4, 6, 8, so that it is also means the **Earth** primary number is the **"2"**
- The sum of the primary number of "2" and "3" is given single digit of **5**, it is why in the Lu-Shu and Ho-Tou, the single digits of **1,3,5,7,9** are the **Numerals of Heaven**, the **2, 4, 6, 8** are the **Numerals of Earth**; so that the **Numerals of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9** represent **Heaven and Earth** in the ancient Chinese Feng Shui Formulae
- Take the Numerals of 1 - 9 to form the **Square & Circle** (please refer to the Diagram in the print-out text). When we overlap the square and circle diagram, then appears the Lu-Shu 9 palaces on the 2-dimensional

square magic grid, but they're not only limited to the digits of 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9

- If you've learnt maths in University, you should understand the following simple square root calculations, they are: 2^2+4n , 2^3+4n , 2^4+4n and 2^5+4n , where the " \wedge " represents "square of" or "to the power of", the "**n**" **must** ≥ 1 , and can be any number. According to the results, we can always drive out the last single digit either 2, 4, 6, or 8, they are the Numerals of Earth
- Similarly, from the following simple square root calculations, they are: 3^1+4n , 3^2+4n , 3^3+4n , 3^4+4n and 5^n+1 , where "n" must ≥ 1 , and can be any number, according to the results, we can always drive out the last single digit either 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9, they are the Numerals of Heaven; so that the Numerals of the Lu-Shu are not limited to 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, they can expressed **infinitely**
- If the Numerals of Yang Heaven are in **Active Status**, the Numerals of Yin Earth will remain **Still**
- Conversely, if the Numerals of Yin are Activated then the Numerals of Yang will remain still; it is the same manner when we do mapping in the Northern Hemisphere region and Southern Hemisphere region
- **Three Eras Nine Cycles** which consist of 180 years, is normally used as the time period parameter, it can be mapped to any time period
- The Sum of $2+4+6+8 = 20$, is the same as the Sum of $1+3+7+9$ which is also $= 20$. If they're extended to the square of four sides, then it is $42+44+46+48 = 180$, similarly, $41+43+47+49 = 180$, the square is the Earth where on which you're living
- The Earth is also separated as two parts of Yin and Yang, as we say, Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere
- Earth floating in Space has 360 degrees, whereby the Northern Hemisphere occupies 180 degrees and the Southern Hemisphere shares the rest of the 180 degrees. They are a balance of Yin and Yang, and have been recorded on the Feng Shui **Lo-Pan**

- Ancient Chinese Feng Shui Masters a thousand years ago had already considered the **Differences** between the Northern and Southern Hemisphere, but they have another term stated as Heaven and Earth
- There are many **Circles or bounds** on the Lo-Pan which represent different meanings in **various Formulae** frameworks
- For instance, two of them are usually termed as **Outer** bound and **Inner** bound, the **Eight Original Kua** are placed in the opposite directions on each of them
- In the Outer bound, the **Eight Original Kua** start from the **Sham of Wu** and anti-clockwise run to the end of the **Sham of Tze**, they represent the **Heaven Kua**, the **Kua Number** sequence is 9 4 3 8 2 7 6 1, they're the Numerals of the Lu-Shu.
- Similarly, the arrangement of **Eight Original Kua** in the Inner bound start from the **Sham of Tze** and anti-clockwise run to the end of the **Sham of Wu**, they represent the **Earth Kua**, the **Kua Number** sequence is the same, being 9 4 3 8 2 7 6 1.
- The mixture of Heaven Kua and Earth Kua comes out as **Form Kua**, there are a total of **64 I-Ching Form Kua**
- The Kua Number in each **Opposite** direction should always be **Decade Match**, it is the math of the Lu-Shu, they are **1 & 9, 3 & 7, 4 & 6 and 2 & 8**, please refer to the Lu-Shu Grid Diagram. We're using this principle in the Feng Shui Formulae as well
- In Southern Hemisphere Feng Shui Formulae application mapping frameworks, the Inner bound of **64 Form Kua** can be reversed to the Outer bound, such that the 24 Shams can remain the same and **do not** necessary reverse in the Star Charts calculations;
- Of course, it is necessary to consider the **Lu-Shu Numeral Decade Match**, the meaning of event **Effects** on the **Form Kua**, the mapping meaning of **Mountain Star, Water Star, Heaven Star and Annual Star Combinations** at a specified palace, etc.

Furthermore, you need to consider the Relationship between the **Host Five Element** and **Guest Five Element**, then the target residents' **Like and Unlike Life Five Elements**, as well as the investigations of **Form Feng Shui** and **Mindscape Feng Shui**.

You should realise that we're **not** merely playing the **game** of Feng Shui but we're dealing with the **Numerals of Lu-Shu and Ho-Tou** which consists of a lot of secrets and advance math. If you've a very strong fundamental knowledge of **Feng Shui Basic Elements** it is more important than if you just learn some calculations of Feng Shui Formulae.

In actual live cases, if a **Single Sha** or even **Twin Sha(s)** are “**calculated**” by one Formula or a Star Grid Chart in a specified location, that normally does not cause a big Feng Shui problem. The unlucky **Effects** may **not be activated** unless:

- there is another **Form Feng Shui Sha(s)** located or found in the specified time period for a target house
- and, the target resident's fortune cycle has reached a specified time frame

We have widely applied ancient Chinese Formulae Feng Shui in the Southern Hemisphere regions for no more than 10 years. It is impossible in a short period of time to quickly develop a near perfect framework for this region. Our existing Feng Shui frameworks have been used in China for more than two thousands years!

Whether in ancient times or nowadays, Feng Shui research works are still on going by utilising tools, such as the **proven track records** of experiments, **statistical** outcome data analysis and rare **live case** studies.

We don't expect that ancient Chinese Formulae Feng Shui, the development of which was based on the central region of China (ie. the centre of the Northern Hemisphere) can be easy to apply anywhere in the World.

From my practical experience, **Australia is an ideal Country** in the Southern Hemisphere to conduct this type of Formulae Feng Shui research work. Australia consists of **different cultural background** peoples who come from every corner of the World.

Does Chinese Feng Shui Work in the Southern Hemisphere?

During the past five years, I've conducted more than 420 Feng Shui cases in Australia. My clients come from different cultural backgrounds and are born in their original Countries, such as in Europe, the Middle East, North America, the Equator, South-East Asia, North-East Asia, the South Pacific Islands, Australia (both in the Northern region and Southern region) and New Zealand.

Most of them are very happy to get advice from a Chinese cultural background Feng Shui Master, of which I was very surprised when I started my consultations in Australia.

As well, fortunately I've been rewarded by more than 32% of them who continually request my Annual Review Program services. This Feng Shui professional service quality index (average is 20%) is commonly used in Hong Kong and Taiwan, to observe and improve your quality of service. An Annual Review Program is necessary for a client as the Feng Shui Effects will change every year.

It is also an important and valuable asset for my further research work in Australia. As I have a chance to log down any prior occurring matters, whether they're lucky things or unlucky things for this target resident and family.

When I conduct annual review consultations for them, they happily tell me or complain to me about everything that has happened in their family or business since my last consultation.

I can easily track back to my previous work, so that I can adjust the necessary calculations based on prior events, and try to make the most suitable advice for this target resident and family in the following year. These real live experiences can't be gained from anywhere or taught by anyone else!

This practical guidance is suitable for all professional Feng Shui Masters whether we're conducting Feng Shui investigations in the Northern Hemisphere regions or Southern Hemisphere regions.
